CPS ANNUAL MEETING AWARD NOMINATION FORM

Each year at its Annual Meeting, the Connecticut Psychiatric Society presents the following awards.

The award for Service to CPS was instituted in 1988 in memory of Cornelis Boelhouwer, M.D., a former president. Any CPS member who has served the organization in any capacity is eligible.

The award for Service to Patients is named in honor of the late Roger Coleman, M.D., who was known for his advocacy for patients in many settings. It was first awarded to Dr. Coleman, posthumously in 1998. This is awarded to a member who has demonstrated the exemplary devotion to patient care and the commitment to quality, which characterized Dr. Coleman's career.

A third award, known as the Distinguished Citizen Award, is designated for legislators and other public officials, advocates for people with mental illness, and others who have contributed to activities that benefit patients. This award is not necessarily made yearly.
